We are extremely proud to share the news of our GCSE results this year - KHA students have demonstrated hard work and determination throughout their time with us and the outcomes they've achieved are superb. They have risen to the challenge of significant covid disruption over the last couple of years and all achieved the grades they need to continue their education.

There were emotional scenes this morning in our main hall as our students opened their envelopes - they did brilliantly!

Results this year have increased significantly for the school (compared to 2019 examinations), way above national trends for improvements in England.

The vast majority of students have exceeded their post-16 course entry requirements and many have secured places at prestigious sixth form colleges.

We had a number of students who achieved top grades in ALL their subjects. Emilyya Yusri, Ruby Gambrill, Deborah Odule and Salman Cagin are notable examples, having achieved exceptional grades across every GCSE they took. There were also 11 students who managed to achieve a Grade 9 in one or more subjects - this is the highest possible grade and places them in the top 7% of students nationally for the respective subject.

I'd like to thank our teachers for their unwavering commitment to our student's academic achievement, our parents for their continual support, and most importantly our wonderful year 11 students for everything they have put into getting these results! They deserve all the success they have achieved, and we look forward to seeing them back at KHA to inspire the next generation.
