What are my Options post 16?

A 'Post 16 Options' webinar will be live streamed to the classrooms of years 9, 10 and 11 on Thursday November 5th. The Post 16 session looks at the different options after year 11 including BTEC's, A Levels and Apprenticeships. Students explore the difference between College and Sixth Form and look at applying to sixth form, college and apprenticeships and make a start on their personal statement.

After this initial session, year 11 students who would like to know more about University Life and Finance will have the benefit of two extra sessions:

10:00-10:45 University Life Students will be introduced to the benefits of higher education. They will learn about the different aspects of student life and explore the differences between school, college and university. Students will also look into different types of courses available to study at university.

10:50-11:35 Student Finance This session will help to dispel some of the myths around the cost of study at university and introduce them to the student loan system. To give them an insight into budgeting as a university student, pupils will also take part in a game where they have to prioritise their money as a university student would.
