Dear Parent / Carer

I hope my letter finds you and your family well as we head closer to results day in August. I know that these remain challenging times so I write to provide you with further information regarding Year 11 arrangements.

I remind you that, at present, we are not permitted to share the Teacher Assessed Grades that we recently submitted to the exam boards – this directive comes from Ofqual. In the meantime, I politely request that you do not ask any members of staff for the grades awarded by the school as we are unable to provide you with this information.

If you require explanation or clarification of our approach to awarding Teacher Assessed Grades, please refer to documents on the school website under the 'Pupil Info' tab. I will write to you again shortly with details of the processes involved in appealing grades.

Exam Results Day - Thursday 12th August

GCSE results day this year is on Thursday 12th August when students are welcome to come into school to collect their results as follows:

Surnames with initials A to L – 10am – 10.30am

Surnames with initials M to Z – 10.30am – 11am

The results will be available in the Main Hall at the stated times and it would be helpful if students could bring a pen as they will be required to sign to acknowledge receipt of results. Unfortunately, only students will be allowed to collect their own results in person. Any results not collected will be posted, second class, later that day. The results will be on printed on school headed paper with full certificates available later in the year.

If arriving by car, please park on the lower tennis courts. If on foot, students should also arrive via the lower tennis courts. Everyone is asked to enter via the tennis court door to the gym, enter the hall to collect results, leave immediately via the door at the side of the hall and return outside to the lower tennis courts. Each student may be accompanied by one parent only, if desired.

We are all frustrated at not being able to come together to celebrate Year 11 achievements this term but I would like to take this opportunity to wish all students the very best for the future.
