SCHOOL DAY EXPECTATIONS

ENTERING SCHOOL

Enter **calmly**, ensuring you consider our community at all times.

Enter in **full school uniform** - shirt tucked in, blazer on, tie on, wearing school shoes.

Put **phones/airpods** away before you enter the gates.

Arrive by **8:45AM** at the latest - later than this will result in a **30 minute late detention** in the hall at the end of the day.

Go **straight** to Period 1.

MAKING YOUR WAY TO LESSON

Take off your coat as soon as you enter the building. **No hoodies** to be worn in or around school. Hoodies will be confiscated and you can collect them at the end of the school day.

Head **straight** to your lesson - we will be conducting corridor SPOT CHECKS. If you are not in lesson you will receive a **30 minute same day detention**.

Walk on the **left** and respect everyone on the corridor.

Line up **quietly** outside your classroom until you are asked to enter.

Enter the classroom **calmly** with a positive attitude; ready to learn.

LESSON EXPECTATIONS

Every lesson you enter will start with a **knowledge retrieval task**. The task will always be on the board as you enter the room and therefore, as part of your routine of learning, it is expected that you make a start at completing the task in **silence** and **independently** without needing to be prompted by your teacher.

You are accountable for your learning. It is an expectation that your teacher will regularly assess your progress in lessons. You will be **cold-called**, asked to demonstrate your understanding on **mini-whiteboards** and to produce more **extensive tasks** independently.

In order to ensure a **focused** and **productive** learning environment for all, your teacher will clearly establish the working conditions for each part of your lessons. We expect you to follow these expectations without the need to be reminded. Unless you are working as part of a group, there should only be **one voice**.

You play a vital role in the learning that takes place in every lesson. Your actions and attitude towards learning contribute towards a positive learning environment. Every pupil at KHA has the right to learn in a safe, calm and focused classroom. We expect you to respect this and to ensure your behaviour takes into consideration the learning and wellbeing of everyone you share your lessons with.

LESSON EXPECTATIONS

Of course, if you consistently meet or exceed our high expectations, you will be **rewarded** by your teachers.

MOVING BETWEEN LESSONS

Wait **quietly** for dismissal; ensure your uniform is correct.

Exit the classroom **calmly** and go **straight** to your next period - we will be conducting corridor SPOT CHECKS. If you are not in lesson you will receive a **30 minute same day detention**.

Walk on the **left** and respect everyone on the corridor.

Keep your **voice down** so as not disturb lessons. Anti-social behaviour will result in an **hour detention** the following day.

Use the toilet at break and lunch **only** - **not** in between lessons and **not** in lessons. Toilet planner passes are now void; Medical cards are not.

FORM TIME

Be **punctual** to form - we will be conducting corridor SPOT CHECKS. If you are not in form on time you will receive a **30 minute same day detention**.

Line up **quietly** outside your form-room until you are asked to enter.

Sit down and silently **read** the form notices whilst the register is taken.

Complete the form activities with **focus**.

Make sure your **uniform is correct** before you are dismissed.

ASSEMBLY

Line up in **alphabetical order**.

Line up **quietly**.

Make sure your uniform is correct before you enter the hall - **blazers on, coats off**.

Wait **silently** for the assembly to begin.

Sit **silently** and wait to be dismissed, then exit the foyer **promptly**.

BREAK AND LUNCH TIME

Do not enter areas that are out of bounds (barriers show out of bounds areas). Anti-social behaviour will result in an **hour detention** the following day. **Do not** make physical contact with any members of the community.

Enter D block toilets by the stairs next to the canteen.

Do not use you mobile phone as it will be confiscated.

Put your rubbish in the bin - **do not litter**.

If playing on the courts, you must **sign equipment in and out**. At the end of break/lunch go **directly** to your lesson.

INTERACTIONS WITH ONE ANOTHER

Do not physically or emotionally harm members of the community.

Do not intimidate members of the community.

Do not speak negatively about members of the community.

Do not incite violence.

Do not argue with members of the community.

RESPECTING YOUR ENVIRONMENT

One person per toilet cubicle.

Toilets are for going to the toilet in - **not eating or socialising.**

Use the sanitary bins provided.

If you break/damage it **you** pay to fix it.

Put your rubbish in the bin - **do not litter.**

LEAVING SCHOOL

Do not take your phone out until you have exited the school gates.

Walk **calmly** and **sensibly** to the school gates.

Do not shout and scream - consider the community outside the school gates.

Avoid hanging around in **groups** outside the school gate.

Respect the community - consider your language choices and actions.

WHAT WE PUNISH VS WHAT WE REWARD

ANTI-SOCIAL/ANTI-LEARNING BEHAVIOURS RESULT IN AN **HOUR DETENTION.**

These behaviours are:

- Littering
- Causing harm to any members of the community
- Shouting in the corridors
- Disrupting lessons
- Not following instructions
- Being late to lessons (30 minute same day detention)
