We look forward to seeing these brilliant posters up around the school!

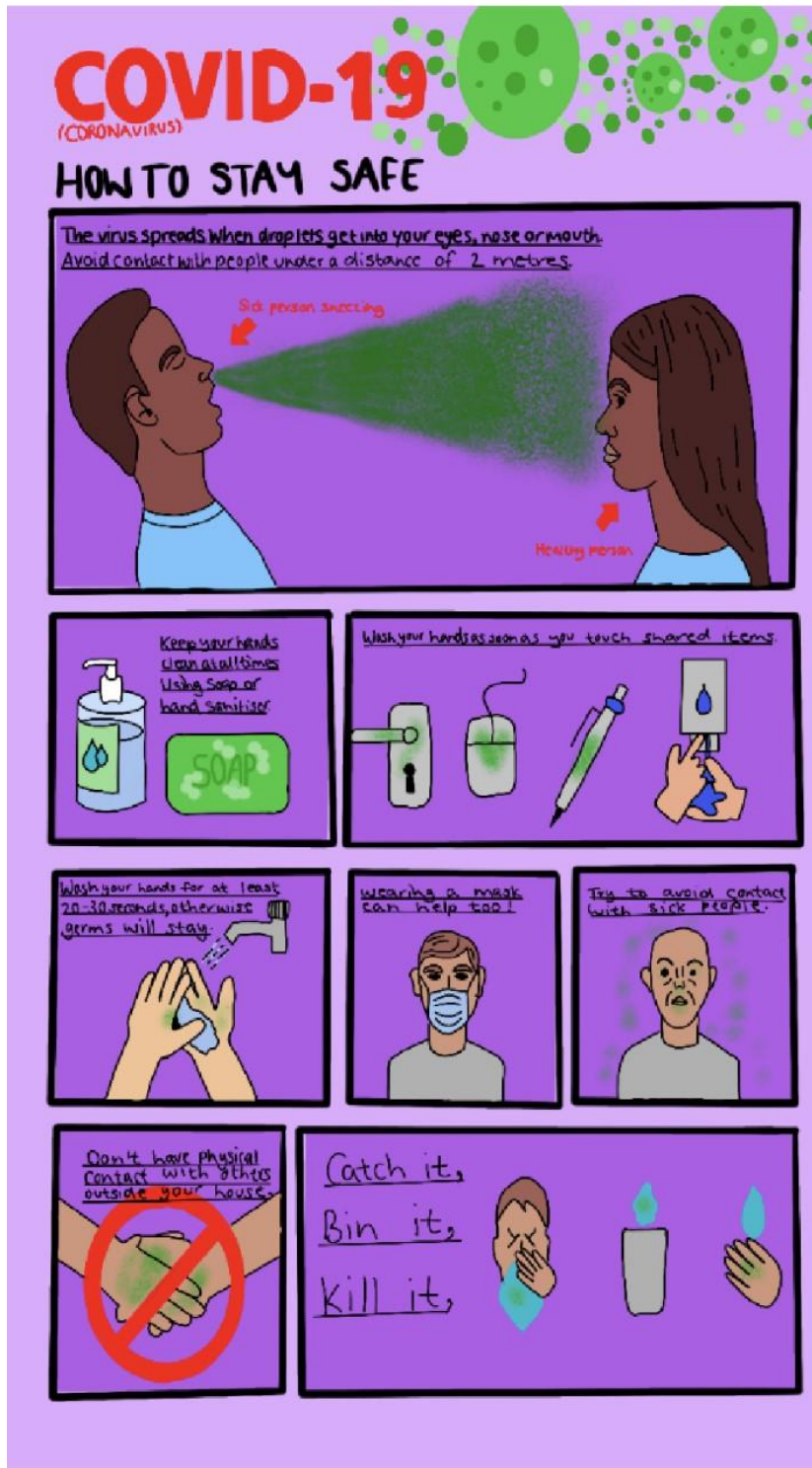
