### **Return to School and Testing Arrangements**

Thank you to those parents and carers who have already completed the consent form for your child/ren to be tested using the lateral flow tests in school. If you have not already completed the consent form can you please do so by the end of Thursday this week, 4<sup>th</sup> March. I understand that some pupils may be anxious about the testing process, but I would encourage you to complete the consent form as this will give our trained staff the opportunity to give guidance and support to our pupils for the first 3 tests before all pupils move to home testing. Under the current guidance we will not be able to supply home test kits to any pupils that have not been testing in school. However, we are awaiting a further update on this point.

Pupils are to arrive at the lower black gates and make their way to the main hall where they will be met by a member of staff. Any pupils who **do NOT have a completed consent form will NOT be tested and be asked to return home**. Pupils are to come onto site for testing purposes only.

Pupil attending site for testing purposes **DO NOT** need to wear school uniform.

**When Year 11 return to school on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> March they will be expected to wear full uniform along with year 10 when they return to school on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> March.**


**Our Key worker and Vulnerable pupils' groups will also be expected to wear full uniform from Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> March.** The vulnerable and key worker bubble group for year's 11 and 10 will integrate back into the main school timetable from next week. All remaining pupils will return to school on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2021.

The school canteen will be open from Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> March with a limited offer in the first instance returning to a full service on 15<sup>th</sup> March.
