Year 11 Study Leave arrangements

Year 11 are now coming to the end of their studies at King Harold and we are now at a point where students can be released for study leave. Where students have not finished all exams in a subject, they are still expected to attend lessons in that subject to ensure they are prepared. All students will be registered whether they are in exam or in a lesson and all absences will be followed up as normal in those subjects where exams are still to be taken. Golden lessons will continue to run on for those students who wish to attend extra sessions. Period one interventions will now stop, students should come into school at 8.30am for morning exams or the start of period two for lessons that are still running.

It is vital that students keep attending lessons in subjects where exams have not yet been sat so that they can receive the expert direction from their teachers. Where students have time between these lessons the LRC will be available for them to study. Students will be expected to sign **in and out** at Pupil Services. Students are expected to wear normal school uniform whenever they are attending school.

Students have been given a timetable which informs them of pre-examination revision sessions, it is vital students come in for these sessions in order to best prepare themselves for that subject exam.

May we also take the opportunity to remind you that the Year 11 rewards trip to Thorpe Park is **Tuesday 25th June** for those who are eligible and have handed in their reply slips. The Year 11 Leavers assembly is **Friday 5th July** and parents are invited to attend. Refreshments will be served from 8.30am and the assembly will start at 9.00am. This is then followed by the Prom in the evening which starts at 6.00pm.

GCSE results day is **Thursday 22nd August**. Students are able to collect their results between 10.00am and 12.00pm in the LRC.

Finally, we would like to wish all of the Year 11 students luck with their futures and to thank you for supporting the school over the last five years.
