What can you expect in Year 7 and 8

Transition support: access to an Options interview with a qualified impartial Careers Guidance Adviser. Have access to a careers software programme Job Explorer Database (JED) for career exploration. Attend Careers Fair to enable students to access employers, colleges, sixth forms, universities and industry experts

What can you expect in Year 10 and Year 11

A one to one interview with a qualified, Impartial Careers Guidance Adviser, Work Related small group sessions. Visits to colleges and sixth forms. Attend an Apprenticeship workshop. Support from local businesses and employers on completing an industry specific CV, letter of application, work experience and mock interviews with real local employers. Support in completing applications for apprenticeships, colleges & sixth form. Attend Careers Fair to enable students to access employers, colleges, sixth forms, universities and industry experts. Organised trips to universities.
