Dear Parents/Carers,

As the trip draws closer, I would like to make you aware of the timings of the trip and what your child will be doing over the 2 days.

We will be being picked up by coach at 09:15 on Monday morning and dropped back at 15:30 on Tuesday afternoon. Please could you make sure your students arrive at school on time on Monday (no later than 08:45) and meet staff on the top playground.

Can you please make sure your child has the following essential items for the trip:

- Rucksack or holdall
- Sleeping bag
- Practical clothing to take part in activities
- Suitable footwear i.e. trainers
- Jumper
- Coat/jacket
- Socks and underwear
- Towel
- Wash bag containing toothbrush, toothpaste, soap etc
- Torch

Attached to this letter is a pack containing information about the camp, an example itinerary and frequently asked questions.

We have a 'no tech' rule on all our kids' camps! Camp wilderness is an opportunity for children to get away from the busyness of their everyday lives and spend time away from their screens. Please do not send your child to camp with their phone, or any other high value electricals. Any phones that arrive on camp will be stored in a safe box, so that we can ensure they don't get damaged. If we need to get in contact with you regarding your child's welfare, our staff will have a full list of parents' contact numbers and will be in touch directly.

Finally, may I take this opportunity to again reinforce the trip policy about behaviour in school prior to departure. Could you remind your child that behaviour must be maintained in every aspect of school life in and out of the classroom and we expect your child to uphold our school expectations for the duration of the trip. Failure to do so will result in you needing to pick your child up from Cuffley Park.
